Stock Market Game



Students in the FBLA Stock Market Game (SMG) may work individually or in teams of two to five members to build and manage a successful investment portfolio of stocks, bonds, and mutual funds, using a hypothetical \$100,000. They track their investments over the course of 10 weeks, receiving valuable opportunities to practice math, critical thinking, problem solving, and research skills as well as essential real life money skills.

The Fall 2023 game will run from October 9, 2023 to December 15, 2023. Registration Deadline: October 27, 2023

The **Spring** 2024 game will run from **February 12, 2024 to April 19, 2024**. **Registration Deadline: March 8, 2024**

This national opportunity only costs \$10.95 per team. Each participant must be a paid FBLA member. Additionally, the top 3 chapters by the end of the game will receive a certificate and each member in the team will receive a medallion. The top 3 will also get recognized on both state and national social media, as well as in the Tomorrow's Business Leader publication.
